

***Response to Sun's Question #1: (updated to include question)***

*Q) As a member of town council, how will you go about considering which of these suggestions from call to the public you yourself would propose to be put on as a future agenda item?*

Reviewing Section 2-5-5 of the Town Code regarding the Agenda, submission of a citizen's request as outlined in this question may be done when two or more Council Members request the item be placed on the agenda in accordance with the Agenda Deadline Calendar. (This may also be accomplished during the "Scheduling of Future Agenda Items" meeting segment.) No vote is required for these actions.

It would be my intention to accept a request with the widest latitude, moderated only by its relevance: (1) to town governance, (2) to pending issues, and (3) to the size and complexity of the upcoming agenda(s). If a request did not meet those criteria, or for some unforeseen reason, another Council Member did not agree with me to submit it, I would plan to respond to the individual making the request and perhaps offer suggestions for revision or some alternative action.
